**Q: What vaccine will my workers be offered?**

A: Workers will receive the Moderna or Pfizer-BioNtech vaccine while Astra Zeneca is paused for people under 55.

**Q: Is there a cost for receiving the vaccine?**

A: No, the vaccine is administered free of charge.

**Q: Can I or other workers already working on-site also be vaccinated?**

A: No. The vaccination clinic only has doses available for workers leaving quarantine. Please do not send other workers to the clinic or expect to be vaccinated yourself.

**Q: Will there be interpreters at the clinic to explain what is going on to the workers?**

A: Yes. There will be staff on-site at the vaccination clinic who will communicate with workers in their first language to get consent before they are vaccinated.

**Q: My worker has questions about the vaccine, who should they ask?**

A: Questions can be directed to the program health nurses or SUCCESS staff who take the workers on wellness walks. Please ask them NOT to ask the front desk or other hotel staff.

**Q: Why are agricultural TFWs leaving quarantine being prioritized for vaccinations?**

A: Agricultural TFWs are included in phase two of [BC's vaccination plan](#) under the 'vulnerable populations living and working in select congregated settings' category.

**Q: Can I require my workers be vaccinated?**

A: No. Workers may not be forced to take the vaccine. All workers will be asked for their consent at the clinic.
