Safe Work Procedure

Before approaching portable toilets

- 1. Know the location of your assigned portable toilet
- 2. While waiting for your turn keep a 2-meter distance
- 3. Wash hands prior to entering the stall

During the use of portable toilet

- 1. Prior to use, if any area is soiled (dirty) notify the supervisor immediately and wait until it has been cleaned
- 2. Dispose of all soiled items as per instructions in the stall

After you use

- 1. Leave area clean, disinfect as per instructions in the stall
- 2. Wash hands as per food safety instructions

At all times practice respiratory etiquette:

- Cough or sneeze into your elbow sleeve
- Dispose of tissues in garbage cans
- Wash hands with plain soap and water for at least 20-30 seconds or use an alcohol-based sanitizer often, especially before eating, after using the washroom, before and after work.
- Avoid touching your face
